

## ÁRVERÉSI FELTÉTELEK

Az árverésen történő részvétel az alábbi feltételek szerint zajlik:

1. Az árverés a résztvevők szabad akaratából történik. A C.I.P. Invest Kft. az aukciót az árvezetők megbízásából szervezi, rendezi és vezeti.
2. Minden árverésre beadott tárgy a kiállítás időtartama alatt megtekinthető. Az egyes tételek leírása és tartásfokozatuk meghatározása a C.I.P. Invest Kft. szakértőinek legjobb tudása és ismerete szerint történik. A darabok minden hibájukkal és hiányosságukkal abban az állapotban kerülnek eladásra, amelyben az árverés ideje alatt található. Leütés utáni reklamációt – az átvételtől számított 8 napon belül – csak abban az esetben lehet figyelembe venni, ha a vevő a megvásárolt darabon olyan durva hibát fedez fel, (fűlnyom, javított lyuk, forrasztás) amely a katalógusban nincs feltüntetve. Azonban a teremben árvezető vevő a darabokat „mint megtekintett”-et vásárolja meg. Az árverésvezető az egyes tételeket belátása szerint összevonhatja, szétválaszthatja, elhagyhatja vagy visszavonhatja.
3. A C.I.P. Invest Kft. GARANTÁLJA MINDEN DARAB VALÓDISÁGÁT.
4. A katalógusban Euroban feltüntetett árak egyúttal kikiáltási árak is, amely alatt az egyes tételek nem kerülnek eladásra. A licit rendszerint 10%-onként emelkedik. Leütésre akkor kerül sor, ha a legmagasabb ajánlat harmadszori elhangzását követően nagyobb ajánlat nem érkezik. Bizonytalan esetekben, ha például az ajánlattevő személyét egyértelműen meghatározni nem lehet, vagy ha egy magasabb ajánlatot az árverésvezető véletlenül nem vett észre, az árverésvezető dönt afelől, hogy az árverést folytatja, vagy a szóban forgó tételt újra árverezi.
5. Licittárcsák: az árverés előtt a Kft. számozott tárcsákat ad ki, mely során a licitálónak igazolnia kell személyazonosságát, mely útlevelel vagy személyi igazolvánnyal történt. Ehhez kapcsolja és átmenetileg tárolja a számítógép az ügyfél személyi adatait, melyhez az ügyfél hozzájárul. Ez a számlaadás és a félreértések elkerülése végett szükséges. Az árverés folyamán a számozott tárcsák szolgálnak licitálásra. A vevő felelős azért, hogy a saját nevére szóló tárcsát az árverés folyamán más ne használhassa. Az árverés befejeztével kérjük, hogy a licittárcsákat személyesen adják vissza, abban az esetben is, ha a vevő az árverés során nem vásárolt! Ha az árverés ideje alatt valaki kikéri a számláját, korábbi tárcsaszáma megszűnik. Amennyiben később tovább kíván licitálni, úgy új tárcsaszámot kell kiváltania.
6. Az árverésen való részvétel írásos vételi megbízás alapján, valamint az árverés időtartama alatt telefonon keresztül történő ajánlat útján is lehetséges. Telefonos ajánlat csak egyenként minimum 500 euró feletti kikiáltási ár esetén lehetséges. Az írásbeli ajánlat realizálását vételi megbízásnak megfelelően a C.I.P. Invest végzi. 7. A leütés a vevőt a tétel(ek) átvételére és az ellenérték kifizetésére kötelezi. Minden vásárló saját nevében, saját számlájára vásárol. Harmadik fél részére történő vásárlás nem lehetséges! Az adott tárcsaszámra történő leütések utólag nem megváltoztathatóak! Készpénzfizetés esetén a számlaadás dátuma egybeesik a fizetés napjával.
8. Az árverési járulék a leütési ár 20%-a. A leütési ár és az árverési járulék együttesen képezi a vételárat. A vételár tartalmazza a C.I.P. Invest Kft. által megfizetendő 25%-os különbözeti ÁFÁT, amely nem visszaigényelhető. Minden interneten keresztül történő vásárlás esetén – „élő ajánlattevés” – az árverési járulék felett, a leütési ár 2,5%-ával növekszik a számla összege.

## AUKTIONSBEDINGUNGEN

Die Teilnahme in der Versteigerung erfolgt nach den folgenden Bedingungen:

1. Die Versteigerung erfolgt nach freiem Wille der Kaufinteressenten. Die Firma C.I.P. Invest Kft. organisiert, veranstaltet und geleitet die Versteigerung im Auftrag der Versteigler.
2. Jeder Gegenstand, der zur Versteigerung abgegeben wurde, kann während der Zeitraum der Ausstellung besichtigt werden. Die Beschreibung der einzelnen Lose und die Bestimmung deren Steigerungsstufen erfolgt nach den besten Gewissenhaftigkeiten und Kenntnisse der Spezialisten der Fa. C.I.P. Invest Kft. Die Lose werden mit allen ihren Fehler und Mangelhaftigkeit im solchen Zustand verkauft, wie diese während der Zeit der Versteigerung zu befinden sind. Eine Reklamation nach dem Zuschlag – binnen 8 Tage von der Übernahme – kann nur im Falle beachtet werden, wenn der Käufer auf der Lose einen so groben Fehler bemerkt (Ösenspur, repariertes Loch, Lötung), der im Katalog nicht gezeigt wurde. Alle Bieter im Raum kaufen die Lose „wie besehen“. Der Auktionator kann die einzelnen Losen nach eigenen Einsehen zusammenlegen, trennen, weglassen oder zurückziehen.
3. Die C.I.P. Invest Kft. garantiert die Echtheit aller Lose.
4. Die im Katalog angegebenen Preise sind gleichzeitig Ausrufpreise, darunter die einzelnen Losen nicht verkauft werden. Die Steigerungsstufen betragen in der Regel 10%. Einen Zuschlag erfolgt, wenn kein grösser Gebot nach dem dritten Ertönen des höchsten Gebotes eintrifft. In unsicherheiten Fällen, wenn z.B. der Bieter nicht eindeutig identifizieren werden kann, oder der Auktionator ein höheres Gebot zufällig nicht bemerkt hat, entscheidet der Versteigerungsleiter über den Fortführung der Auktion, oder wird die betroffene Lose wieder versteigert.

Während der Versteigerung dienen die Bieternummer zur Lizitation. Selbst der Käufer ist verantwortlich dafür, dass die auf seinen eigenen Namen gegebenen Bieternummer anderer Kaufinteressierte nicht benutzen werden kann. Nach der Versteigerung bitten um die persönliche Rückgabe der Bieternummer, auch im Falle, wenn der Kaufinteressente während der Versteigerung nicht gekauft hat. Wenn jederman seine Rechnung während der Versteigerung verlangt, erlischt seinen früheren Bieternummer. Falls er später wieder lizitieren will, so muss er einen neuen Bieternummer beantragen.
6. Teilnahme in der Versteigerung kann auch auf Grund der schriftlichen Kaufbeauftragung erfolgen, sowie während der Versteigerung mit telefonisch abgegebenen Geboten ist es auch möglich. Ein telefonisches Gebot ist nur über einen Ausrufpreis von min. 500 EUR per Lose möglich. Die Realisierung des schriftlichen Gebotes wird entsprechend der Kaufbeauftragung der Fa. C.I.P. ## PURCHASE BY SALE

Participation on auction happens under the following conditions:

1. The auction happens from the free will of the participants. The company of C.I.P. Invest organises, arranges and manages the auction on behalf of the clients.
2. All objects being in the auction may be seen during the exhibition. The description of each lot and identification of its increasing jumps happens according to the best knowledge of the specialists of C.I.P. Invest. The each lot will be sold with its all defets and deficiencies in a condition, as they are during the auction. A claim after hammering – within 8 days after receipt – can be taken into account only in case if the buyer notices on the bought lot such a rough defect (earmark, repaired hole, soldering) which can't be found in the catalogue. The buyers attending the auctions yourself buy however the pieces „as described”. The auctioneer may the lots reduce, separate, leave or withdraw according to his lights.
3. The C.I.P. Invest guarantees that all pieces are genuine.
4. The Euro prices in the catalogue are at the same time put-up prices, which means that bids below can't be accepted. The bid will be increased generally by 10% jumps. A hammering occurs if the highest bid will announced three times and no higher bid arrives. In uncertain cases, for example the personage of the bidder can't be identify unanimously, or the auctioneer a higher bid overlooked by mistake, the leader of auction has the right to re-open the bidding or recall the lot and put it up for sale again.
5. Bidder number: before the auction the C.I.P. Invest issues numbered discs, while the bidders must identify himself by their passport or identity card. The computer connects and stores the personal data of the clients temporarily to the bidder number to which the clients give their permission. This is necessary because of the invoicing and avoiding the misunderstanding. During the auction the numbered discs serve for bidding. The buyer is responsible that his disc can't be used by another person during the auction. At the end of the auction we ask you to give back the bidder number personally also in case he didn't bought during the auction. If everybody requires his invoice during the auction, his previous bidder number no more exists. If he wants to bid further, he has to request a new bidder number.
6. The participation in the auction can happen by writing or during the auction by phone. A bid by phone can be made only if the put-up price is over 500 Eur per piece. The realization of the written bid will be made by C.I.P. Invest according to the buying-commission. In case the personage of the bidder is unknown – in the interest of secure of payment – C.I.P. Invest ask for a deposit 20%. In case of written buying commission the deposit is the 20% of the bid, and it is in case of a bid made by phone 40% of the put-up price. This amount must be transferred to the account of the C.I.P. Invest latest on 10. June 2011 at 12,00 o'clock. Failing this the C.I.P. Invest may the bid neglect. In case of an unsuccess bid transfers the C.I.P. Invest the amount of advance immediately after the auction. If the bidding was successful, the deposit will be applied to the purchase money.
7. The hammering obliges the buyer to the taking over the goods and paying its price. All buyer purchases for its own name and account. There is no possible to buy for a third person. The hammerings for a given bidder number can't be change later. In case of a cash payment the date of the invoice is the same as the date of the payment.
8. The buyer's premium is 20% of the hammer price. The hammer price and the buyer's premium together are the purchased price. The purchased price includes the hungarian VAT which will be paid by C.I.P. Invest, and can't be refund. Internet live bidder have to pay over the buyer's premium, plus 2,5% internet fee.
9. The floor buyers are bound to pay the purchase price immediately on the auction place. The buyer obtains the ownership of the good put up for auction only after paying the total purchased price. On the base of a previous discussion the C.I.P. Invest ensures – with paying a deposit 20% – the possibility of a payment within 15 days after auction. The deposit must be paid immediately on the place of auction in cash or with VISA or MASTER CARD credit cards. Failing this the lot in question can be put up for auction again. In case of paid advance get the buyer the ownership of the lot after paying the total invoice amount. In case of a written or by phone made commission the purchase price must be transferred within 15 days after receiving the hammer price or to pay in cash in our office.
10. In case of a default payment – after 15 days – the C.I.P. Invest is obliged to account monthly 3% interest on default. If the default payment exceeds 45 days the C.I.P. Invest is bound to terminate the contract with accounting of a failure penalty of 30% which will be deducted from the deposit.
11. In case of any disputes both parties conform themselves depending on the contractual amount the exclusive competence of Central District Court of Pest and Budapest Capital Court respectively. The Court acts according to the Hungarian law.

In sharp contrast to the profusion of coin types issued by his predecessor Augustus, the coinage of Tiberius is immensely conservative, in gold and silver comprising only two different designs issued over the entirety of his 23-year reign. The types here – Tiberius' laureate portrait backed with a seated female holding a sceptre and branch, usually described as Livia portraying Pax – are identical to the motifs found on the silver denarius commonly called the "Tribute Penny" for its supposed role in the famous "shall we pay tribute to Caesar" scene depicted in the Gospel of Matthew. In the Roman system, a gold aureus was worth 25 silver denarii, representing enormous purchasing power. During Tiberius' reign, a low-ranking Roman soldier's annual salary was only 225 denarii or nine gold aurei.
